THE FARLINGTON FOUNDATION LOTTERY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Definition

We meet the criteria of a lottery, as defined by the Gambling Commission:¹

- Payment is required to participate
- Two or more prizes are awarded
- Those prizes are awarded by chance

Registration

The lottery will be registered with Horsham District Council.

Purpose

The Fundraising purpose is solely to generate funds for the Farlington Foundation from members of the Farlington School and alumni community, and is not a public lottery.

Run By

The Lottery will be run by volunteers of the Farlington Foundation.

Participation

Participation is open to parents, grandparents, pupils over the age of 16, alumni and other 'friends of Farlington', and those members of Farlington School staff not directly involved in the administration of this lottery.

Subscription

£5 per month, payment by standing order, paid into the Farlington Foundation lottery account (details: CAF Bank Sort Code 40-52-40 Account Number: 00029013) on the 5th of each month. A standing order for £60 may be made for an annual subscription. Alternatively, payment may be made by cheque (annual subscription only).

Each participant will be allocated a unique Draw Number, and a printed ticket will be issued on receipt of the first monthly payment. These tickets are not transferrable.

Multiple entries are permitted. Each entry will be allocated a separate Draw Number.

Draw

The draw will take place on the second Tuesday of each month, or on a date as close as possible to this day of the month. The draw will be undertaken by a member of the Farlington Foundation committee, supervised by an independent witness.

Winning numbers will be selected by a random electronic selection method, and winners advised by the last working day of that month. A list of winners will be available upon request.

If payment has not been received from the winning participant the Farlington Foundation reserves the right to re-draw and select another winner.

Prize Fund

The prizes awarded will be a cash payment. The prize pot will be not more than 50% of payments received, and will be broken down into a suitable number of prizes. The Foundation reserves the right to vary prizes without notice.

'Super draws' may be held at the Foundation's discretion, but typically two per year.

Age

No person under the age of 16 may take part in this lottery.

Account reconciliation.

The account will be reconciled monthly to confirm full participation. It is the participant's responsibility to advise the Foundation of changes of contact details, bank account details or the intention to surrender a lottery ticket number.
