SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are awarded on merit and will be held for the duration of the pupil's time at Farlington, subject to annual review. Farlington is proud of its scholars and with a scholarship comes responsibility; pupils are expected to be an excellent ambassador for their chosen area both in and outside School. We have high expectations and pupils are encouraged to give something back to the Farlington community often by supporting and coaching others in their area of expertise.

Prep School

One major award for entry into Prep 3 – the Vive Parva Scholarship – is offered for both internal and external candidates. The Scholarship is a tuition fee remission, and no more than three Scholarships will be made each year, to a total value of not greater than 45% remission. The fee remission will last until the end of Prep 6. The name 'Vive' originates from our school motto 'vive ut vivas' which means, 'live life to the full'.

Senior School

For entry to Year 7 – the Vive Scholarship is offered for a candidate with both outstanding academic prowess and who excels in another area (e.g. sport, music, art, or drama). This award, which may not always be granted, is worth 50% of the tuition fees. We also offer an Academic Scholarship and scholarships in Music, Drama, Art and Sport.

For entry to Year 9 the following scholarships are offered, Academic, Music, Drama, Art and Sport.

Sixth Form

For entry into the Sixth Form, The Vive Magna Scholarship, offers a 50% reduction in tuition fees and is open to students entering the Lower Sixth.

The Vive Magna Scholarship will be awarded to a student who epitomises the Farlington ethos and excels not only academically, but also in at least one other area, for example, Art, Drama, Music or Sport. This scholarship is awarded on merit and may not always be granted.

In addition to the Vive Magna Scholarship, the following Sixth Form Scholarships are also available: Academic, Art, Drama, Music, Sport, Textiles and a more generic Open Scholarship. The Open Scholarship will be awarded to students who demonstrate commitment, ability and potential in an area which is not already mentioned above.

Criteria for Scholarships will be decided by the Education Committee.

There will be public recognition of Scholars and all pupils who maintain their Scholarships until they leave will be further acknowledged on their final Speech Day.

Detailed procedures and timelines are issued each year in the 'Entrance Booklet'.

Scholarships are available at four points of entry:

Entry into Prep 3: Examination in January

Scholarships are available to both internal and external candidates. Candidates should be registered and entered by the last Friday in the preceding November.

Entry into Year 7: Examination in January

Scholarships are available to both internal and external candidates. Candidates should be registered and entered by the last Friday in the preceding November. All external pupils who sit the Entrance Examination in January will automatically be considered for Academic Scholarships so there is no need to apply for these.

Entry into Year 9: Examination in January

Scholarships are available to both internal and external candidates. Candidates should be registered and entered by the last Friday in the preceding November.

Entry into the Sixth Form: Examination in November

Scholarships are available to both internal and external candidates. Candidates should be registered and entered by the first Monday in November as the assessment will take place later that month.

Candidates offered a place or a Scholarship may also apply for a bursary. However, the value of the Scholarship awarded will be taken into account when the bursary is assessed.
